New production line in Poland

The Rockwool Group has decided to go ahead with the building of a new production line at the Malkinia factory in Poland. The project - which is estimated to cost approx. DKK. 500 mill. (€70 mill.) - will almost double the capacity of the factory.

The new line is expected to be operational in July 2008 and will provide jobs for additional 70 employees in the area.

With the increased capacity in Malkinia, the Rockwool Group is well positioned to take full advantage of the strong upswing in the region. The new line will service the strong growing markets in Poland, Ukraine, Belarus and the Baltics.

The Rockwool Group operates two factories in Poland, one in Malkinia in the Eastern part of the country and one in Cigacice in the Western part of the country. In 2005, Poland accounted for approx. 7% of the Rockwool Group's total turnover of DKK 10 bn (€1.3 bn).
